What is PI/CPC?

P.I. stands for Public Information. This committee carries AA's message of recovery to the still-suffering alcoholic by informing the public about the A.A. program.

C.P.C. stands for Cooperation with the Professional Community. This committee brings the A.A. message to professionals and to students attending professional schools in our community, helping them to understand how and why A.A. works.

How Can You Help?

- Volunteer to speak at Schools, DUI Programs, and with Health Professionals about what AA is and what AA is not.
- Help with the launch of a Public Service Announcement Campaign in Los Angeles through placement of GSO approved radio and TV PSA's as well as outdoor and print media vehicles.
- Deliver Meeting Schedules & Pamphlets to DUI facilities.
- Set up booths at health fairs and other appropriate public and professional facing activities to pass on information about what AA is and what AA isn't.
